Meeting called to order at 8:53a

Approval of January EB meeting Minutes- Trina Cone

Trina motioned to vote to approve the minutes Kris seconded with the Board approving the minutes with a unanimous vote.

Principal Update -Mr. Conner

- Introductions and thank you for the basket © and for the Staff Appreciation on Wednesday
 - o Great appreciation for the meet and greet at Mellow Mushroom
 - Board members all shared personal stories about meeting Mr. Conner's delightful wife and how kind it was of his family to drive up from SC to surprise him
 - Mr. Conner is from Myrtle Beach and taught there at the beginning of his career
 - He now lives up in Kannapolis with his wife
- Great first week at AGMS- planning on working at school this weekend
- New Dean and Behavior Support position
 - Mr. Conner is going to hire these 2 positions to add support
 - Lots of social media posts and drama that comes from those posts within the student population
 - Restorative conferences with young ladies involved have been taking place
- Schoolwide data is back and AG did not meet growth measurements last year
 - This is at the top of Mr. Conner's priority list
 - 7th grade math exceeded growth
 - 80 percent of students took EOGs last year (typically 95%)
 - Growth calculated on State projections from the past 3 years
 - -4.70 growth level
 - Differentiation of instruction was discussed
 - Mr. Conner is addressing increasing differentiation with teachers
- Feedback from parents that Teacher communication is less
 - o Teachers have less down time as they are covering classes and have lost some planning times
 - Mr. Conner to remind teachers to keep up communications
 - Grade level meetings to be held on Monday, 2/14



- Vacancy in 6th grade ELA
 - o have a guest teacher in there to assist
 - Ms Payne's kids being dispersed for her bereavement leave. Mrs. Hennessey is helping to cover
- Vacancy in ECGE assistant vacancy (visual assistant vacancy0
- Feedback from parents regarding test taking on current platform
 - Kids cannot go back and see what they missed on tests
 - Mastery Connect is new this year. Teacher created assessments can be changed to the settings to review, by state tests cannot.
 - Gap in ELA with being assessed on subjects that the students have not heard before
- EL curriculum- the disconnect is the EOGs are multiple choice and EL is not set up to be multiple choice School
- Psychologist to do a staff presentation on how to walk students through their emotions
 - o Introduce Ruler- Regulation of emotions (Recognize Understand Label Express Regulate)
 - Mood meter –to get new vocab to the students
- 8th grade social Idea
 - 8th grade formal for the kids in May after EOGs
 - o Food location, DJ, etc
 - Incentive for 8th graders to attend the end of year party
- · Community within the building
 - House system- intergrade community
 - Ron Clark academy in Atlanta
 - Discussion on how to fund sending teachers from AGMS
 - Explanation of houses- like Hogwartz in Harry Potter, mixes students from different grades and rewards and encourages good behavior

Financial Report/AG Fund- Shelly Cole

- AG Fund at \$57,000
 - Below the goal, but this feels like the new population of donators- so might adjust next year's projections.
 - This year might be the new baseline.
 - Difference is even bigger than the numbers show because of corporate sponsorship- so parent donation is actually down more than the numbers reflect.
- Kris and Kim met and reconciled numbers and everything lined up
- Currently have 1299 students
- \$107k carryover from not spending last year.
 - Cushion from last year.
 - Take into account to keep a cushion
- Grade level expenses come at the end of the year
- Instructional support- IXL was paid



- Study Island & Brain Pop- the school paid for Study Island
- Capitol improvement \$11k
- Campus beautification have a pressure washing to schedule
- \$6200 Bulldog Club account
 - Suggestion to transfer funds back to Bulldog Club
 - Before 2019 Bulldog Club was part of PTO
 - o Bulldog Club now on their own 501C 3 quickly so had limited amount of money they could accept
 - Kip Keiger is the President
- Brain Pop subscriptions expires in April
 - o Mr. Conner to check on if Brain Pop is being utilized by teachers

 - Acct & money
