Students will learn to cooperate with each other and learn proper online etiquette while using the online software. Learning social skills while playing online games helps develop critical thinking skills as they create their online worlds.  |
| Basketball Skills Club             | Danielle Lunsford<br>Mon<br>3:45-5:45        | Basketball Skills Club will involve several drills and activities to teach the students how to control the basketball, dribble, pass, shoot, etc. We will play games like knockout, work on offense and defense, and do a lot of 3 v. 3 or 5 v. 5. Overall, the club will be very engaging, fun, and exciting.  |
| Classic Films Club                 | Mr. Chris Alexander<br>Wed<br>3:45-5:45      | The Classic Film Club will be a unique offering where participants watch all types of cinematic films, depending on the content. The club introduces club members to movies that only a small population would know about or have seen such as: "Citizen Kane"; "Psycho"; "Sunder"; "Carmen Jones"; and "The Imitation of Life". We will evaluate the films and discuss the socio-economic and political consequences surrounding the films and their making. |
| Tabletop Dungeons and Dragons Club | Ian Fuller<br>Thursday<br>3:45-5:45          | Tabletop D&D roleplaying is a cooperative game where the players use cooperation, imagination, and creativity to create a story that is player driven. All are welcome and no experience is required. Chromebooks or other technology is helpful but not a requirement. This club will meet once a week each Tuesday for two hours.   |
