2. Financial Report *Carolyn Floyd/Tempie Largen*
 - Mickie Huneycutt reviewed the attached financials. Not much financial activity.
3. Principal Report *Mr. Conner*
 - AG will be losing the Student Weighted Staffing (SWS), which was the money received from Covid government money which funded AG staffing. Mr. Conner discussed positions that could be at risk.
 - Mr. Conner reviewed the Hero points system with the board. There are parent concerns that teachers are not giving points and students are therefore not able to participate in the incentive program. The PTA board can encourage our parents to give the teachers grace. The system is not perfect. The Hero system is required for all teachers to use and is the main behavior system used at AG.

5. Other Business *Carolyn Floyd/Tempie Largen*
 - The draining process on the fields will not occur. If it does occur, it will go through CMS, not the Bulldog Club or the AG PTO. CMS has said no PTO funding can go towards the fields and building facilities. CMS will take the lead on the draining project. Mr. Conner explained the reasoning behind not being able to build new drains due to the reservoir and the SouthPark Selwyn, AG, MP footprint. The drainage may be clogged and CMS will first attempt to clean drainage first.
